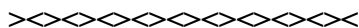

ANSWER: Did you know that the Sacraments of Initiation are: Baptism, Confirmation & Holy Eucharist. They were re-ordered, placing Holy Eucharist before Confirmation, in 1910 by Pope Pius X who was concerned that children were not receiving the Holy Eucharist until they were 12 or 14 years of age.
