11-11-1918 - 11-11-2018

Remembering all Irishmen and
Irishwomen who served and died in
W.W.I. Particularly those men from
Kilmead, Fonstown, Crookstown and
Ballytore.

Brothers James and Arthur Dempsey
(James was Birdie Martin's father) and

Matthew Bell, all from
Fonstown. Christopher Browne -
Ballytore (Killed in action). Andrew
Delaney - Crookstown died of gas
poisoning; his brother William (killed in
action). James Merrins Ballytore cause
of death unknown.

They will always be remembered.
On this day when we recall the end of
the 'Great War', the 'War to end all
Wars', we pray for peace. Peace without
justice is unsustainable, if we want
peace we must work for justice.

SPECIAL COLLECTION - TODAY.

THOUGHT FOR THE DAYS AHEAD...

"I destroy my enemies when I make them my friends." ~Abraham Lincoln.

ANSWER: Did you know that the last Ecumenical Council happened between 1962 & 1965, and was called the Second Vatican Council (*the First Vatican Council had been held between 1869 & 70*) or Vatican II? Some of the key teachings of the council were: Mass to be said in the local language (not Latin), the priest faced the people and there was a renewed focus on the Church being all the baptised, the People of God - this marked a doctrinal shift from the focus on the institutional church.
