THOUGHT FOR THE DAY

What is the hall mark of a Christian? Is it how often we attend mass? - although of course this is essential. Perhaps it is how often or how well we pray - again essential to Christian life? Or does it come down to how much we contribute in either financial terms or indeed of ourselves to the Church? It is fact none of the above! In today's Gospel Jesus makes it very clear that only hallmark for a Christian, the only standard by

which we will be measured is the Love standard.

If we take an honest look at ourselves. If we honestly examine our relationships with other Christians, especially those around us, can we in truth say that an outsider looking in would say 'See how they love one another'? Would our relationships honestly attract others to want to be part of our community? Could it be said of us: "By this love you have for one another, everyone will know that you are my disciples" Jn. 13:35.

ANSWER: FALSE. Did you know that the Lord's Prayer or the Our Father as it is also known does not end with the word 'Amen'? Why? Well because that prayer is the prayer that Jesus gave us, they are His words as we find in Matthew 6: 9-13. And there we see that Amen does not in fact feature. Neither does the Doxology; 'For thine be the kingdom, the power and the glory ... ' appear in the bible. This was in fact a liturgical practice that was added much later. This practice was carried over into the King James version of the Bible but does not appear in the Catholic bible.
