NOTICE REGARDING THE FUTURE USE OF THE PAROCHIAL HOUSE IN CROOKSTOWN

Following considerable consultation and discernment, the Parish Team (Fr Liam Rigney, Fr Tim Hannon, Fr Francis McCarthy, Conor McCann and Natasha Geoghegan) have decided that the best use of the Parochial House in Crookstown is that it be kept as a Parochial House for a priest to live in, rather than developing it as a parish pastoral centre.

In coming to this decision, the Parish Team is particularly appreciative of the Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Committee and of the people who work in the building.

The Parish Office will remain in its present location. The Parish Pastoral Worker's office will be relocated in the adjoining house.

Parish meetings will also be held in the adjoining house, as they had been in the past.

Following this decision, Fr Francis McCarthy has expressed his willingness to move into the Parochial House. It is hoped that this move will be completed during the summer months
