A THOUGHT FOR FATHER'S DAY

There was an animal reserve in an African country where, through poaching, they had lost a large number of Elephants, especially bull or male elephants.

So the authorities, in an effort to replenish the herds imported young bulls from another sanctuary, a good idea on the surface.

Before long the game keepers noticed that the young bulls were becoming violent and destructive and they could not figure out why. It was feared that culling may be required.

In a last ditch effort to avoid the unthinkable they called in some external experts to examine the situation and come up with a solution. It didn't take the experts too long to realise that the problem was clear, as was the solution. The poaching had left a dearth of adult males so the young males had no 'role models' to teach them how to behave. To teach them what it is to be an adult male.

The Trinity is an expression of the different faces or aspects of God. In the Father we see the face of God as creator - the source of life.

In the Son we see God as Saviour or Reconciler, who, when we had turned our back to God came to earth as one of us to show us that living life as the Creator intended was not only possible but it is fact the means by which we truly become what we were created to be. In the Holy Spirit we see the dynamic and powerful face of God. Through whom all things are possible.
