#### A THOUGHT FOR CORPUS CHRISTI

When I was growing up my father would often say, when he didn't agree with my food choices, 'you are what you eat.'

Over the next few days why not take a few moments each day reflecting on and praying about the Eucharist. Why not ask

Jesus to reveal Himself to you in the Eucharist. And give thanks to Him for the gift of Himself to us which, is food for the journey.

We recall the words of St Augustine: "Become what you receive." so that we can make Jesus and HIS message of love, more present in our world.

ANSWER: FALSE Did you know that we are in fact more blessed than those who lived at the time of Jesus? Why? Because we have the fullness of Christ with us all the time in all places.

Christ is fully present in Eucharist. Present Body & Soul.

The Eucharist is not, for Catholics a symbolic presence. The Bread & Wine do not merely 'represent' Jesus' body & blood but are in fact HIS body & blood. The presence of Christ is a real and true presence. To say that it is a real presence is not to diminish the other presences of Christ, especially at mass, but in the Eucharist, the Bread & Wine, Christ is present in a most perfect way.

If you would like to learn more about the real presence then why not look up the Catechism of the Catholic Church paragraphs numbers 1373-1377.
