The Diocese of Dublin and the Irish

the 1st July and  
will be increased to €400 on  
1st January 2020.

and the sacristan. While this fee for  
funerals will be asked for in the Parishes  
of Athy,  
Narraghmore and Moone,  
discretion will be used in all situations  
where families are experiencing financial  
hardship.

**ANSWER:** Did you know that there  
are 5 Precepts of the Catholic  
Church and they are:

- Attendance at Mass on Sundays  
and Holy Days of Obligation.
- Confession of serious sin at  
least once a year.
- Reception of Holy Communion  
at least once a year during the  
Easter season.
- Observance of the days of fast  
and abstinence.
- Providing for the needs of the  
Church.

These 5 precepts are seen as the  
bare minimum that is expected of a  
member of the faithful. But in order  
to grow in holiness and to grow in  
love of God and of our neighbor,  
we need to do a lot more than the  
bare minimum.
