ANSWER: Did you know that there are 5 Precepts of the Catholic Church and they are:

- Attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
- Confession of serious sin at least once a year.
- Reception of Holy Communion at least once a year during the Easter season.
- Observance of the days of fast and abstinence.
- Providing for the needs of the Church.

These 5 precepts are seen as the bare minimum that is expected of a member of the faithful. But in order to grow in holiness and to grow in love of God and of our neighbor, we need to do a lot more than the bare minimum.
