CANONISATION OF BLESSED CARDINAL JOHN HENRY NEWMAN.

Today in Rome Pope Francis will canonise as a saint of the Church, Blessed John Henry Newman the founder of the Catholic University of Dublin which went on to become UCD - now the largest third level institution in Ireland.

Cardinal Newman was born in England and became a priest of the Church of England. After a period of discernment and deep prayer he converted to Catholicism on the October 9th 1845. He was then ordained as a Catholic priest on Trinity Sunday 1847.

In October 2005 a potential miracle was announced; Jack Sullivan, a Catholic deacon in Massachusetts, USA, attributed his recovery from a crippling spinal cord disorder to Blessed John Henry Newman's intercession in heaven. On 3rd July 2009 Pope Benedict XVI approved the

authenticity of the miracle.

A second miracle at the intercession of Blessed John Henry, the healing of a pregnant woman from a grave illness, was approved on February 12th 2019.

Newman was a prolific writer, in addition to his numerous academic works he wrote many hymns and prayers. Perhaps his most famous is:

O Lord, support us all the day long, until the shadows lengthen, and the evening comes, and the busy world is hushed, and the fever of life is over, and our work is done. Then in thy mercy, grant us a safe lodging, and a holy rest, and peace at the last. Amen

TUESDAY OCTOBER 15TH FEAST OF ST TERESA OF AVILA - founder of the Order of Discalced Carmelites and one of only 5 female doctors of the Church, 3 of whom were Discalced Carmelites - St Teresa, St Therese of Lisieux and St Teresa Benedicta (Edith Stein).
ST TERESA OF AVILA - PRAY FOR US.

ANSWER: Did you know that the 3 Archangels are: Raphael - which means Healer of God or God Heals. Gabriel which means Strength of God. and Michael which means who is like God. There was a fourth, Lucifer who rebelled against God and whose name means Light Bearer. Lucifer is now known as the Devil or Satan.
