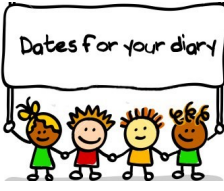

**ANSWER:** Did you know that the Archdiocese of Dublin comprises the Dublin Diocese and the Old Monastic diocese of Glendalough? The two diocese' were unified in 1216 under the pontificate of Pope Innocent III. It was around this time that Dublin's second cathedral was constructed, dedicated to St Patrick. The first cathedral, now Christ Church was dedicated to the Holy Trinity. Both cathedrals are now under the care of the Church of Ireland.
