"Do not try to excuse your faults. Try to correct them."

St. John Bosco.

John 'Don' Bosco, was born in Becchi, Italy, on August 16th, 1815. At the age of two, John's mother was widowed. Despite their poverty his mother found enough to share with the homeless who sometimes came to the door seeking food, shelter or clothing. When John was nine years old, he had the first of several vivid dreams that would influence the rest of his life. In his dream, he encountered a multitude of boys who swore as they played.

A short time later he witnessed a circus. He realized if he learned their tricks, he could use them to attract others.

John was ordained a priest in 1841.

His first assignment was to the city of Turin. While visiting the prisons, Fr. Bosco noticed a large number of boys, between the ages of 12 and 18, inside. The conditions were deplorable, and he felt moved to do more to help other boys from ending up there. He went into the streets and started to meet young men and boys where they worked and played. He used his talents as a performer, doing tricks to capture attention, then sharing with the children his message for the day. In 1859, Fr. Bosco established the Society of St. Francis de Sales.

Fr. Bosco died on January 31st, 1888. He was canonized on Easter Sunday, 1934 and he was given the title, "Father and Teacher of Youth."

Saint John Bosco is the patron saint of apprentices, editors and publishers, schoolchildren, magicians, and juvenile delinquents. His feast day is on January 31st.


