THE REMOVAL OF COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

further On March 31st the last remaining Covidgovernment. In the parishes of Athy, decided, due to still high numbers of Covid-19 in the community, to retain a number of those restrictions. We now feel it is an opportune time to remove them. Accordingly, you are no longer requested to wear a face mask or to respect social distancing, while in the church. However, there are a number of exceptions:

- 1. We will still not offer a contact sign of peace at mass.
- 2. We will still distribute Holy Communion on the hand only.
- 3. We will still request that you use hand sanitiser on entering and leaving the church.

In addition, and in consultation with each local community, we will begin to explore the possibility of: Altar Servers returning, the passing of collection baskets and the use of Holy Water on entering and leaving the church. These decisions will only be taken after consultation with all the relevant parties. **PLEASE NOTE:** that as of April 24th last, the Catholic Bishops have reinstated the Obligation to attend Sunday mass in person. The obligation had been removed at the beginning of the pandemic. The obligation only applies to those who are fit, well and able to attend.

CATECHETICAL CORNER - THE BIRTHDAY OF THE CHURCH

After his resurrection, at the moment in which he returned to his Father, Jesus pours out the Spirit upon his disciples and makes them sharers in his own mission. Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the disciples went out on the first Pentecost Sunday and began to preach the Good News to peoples from all parts of the then known world.

The Spirit enabled the apostles to speak a message which was understandable to all. The Spirit enabled them to teach a message that was relevant and understandable to the lives and the concrete realities of peoples of different backgrounds. The message of Jesus is a universal one, not just in the sense that it has spread right around the world, but above all in that no one, no people is excluded from that message or from the community that Jesus' message constructs.

The disciples of Jesus are brought together in unity by the Holy Spirit. You cannot be a solo-Christian. Christianity is a faith that demands the building of community. The Church is called, according to the opening words of the Vatican Council's Constitution on the Church, to be "a sign and a sacrament of the unity in Jesus Christ of all humankind". *(Lumen Gentium LG I.)* Wherever Church exists, it must be a sign for all to see of unity and community.

We all need community. Community is not just for the few who are naturally gregarious. We need something more than a vague good neighbourliness based on living next-door to each other without enmity or undue friction. We all need real community. Community is where we find support, fellowship, encouragement and nourishment. Community is where we accepted for who we are and challenged to be the best we can be, to live from the best that is in us. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, let's celebrate by strengthening the bonds that unite us asking Mary, Mother of the Church to pray for us. June 6th - Monday after Pentecost - Feast of the Mary, Mother of the Church.
