

God is With Us to the End

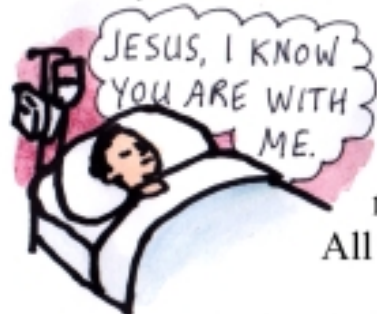

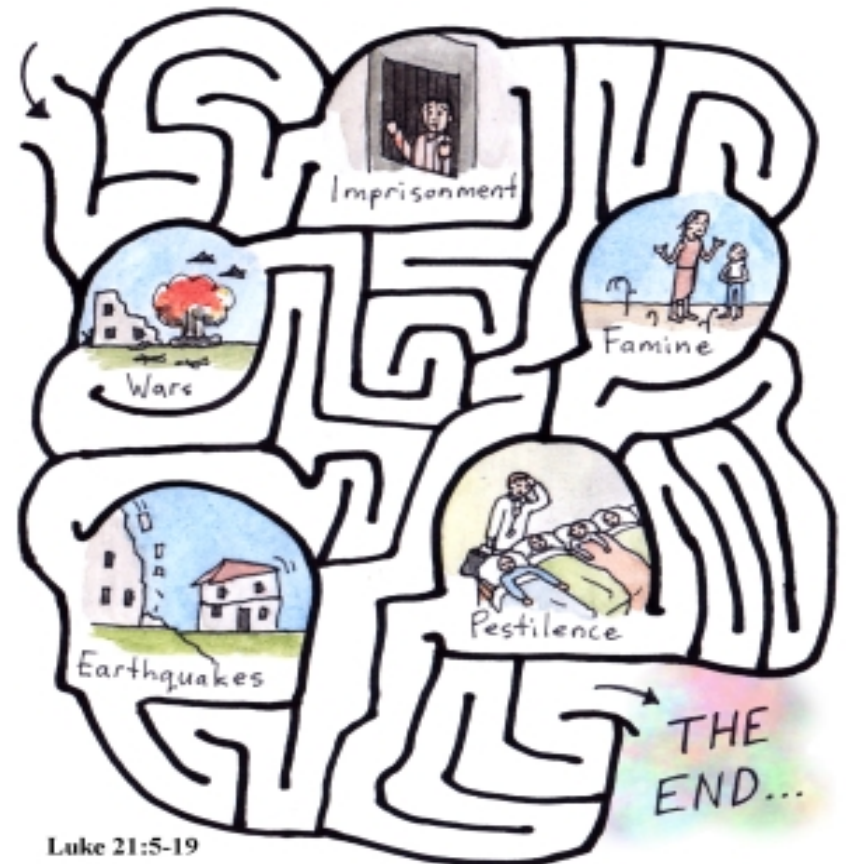

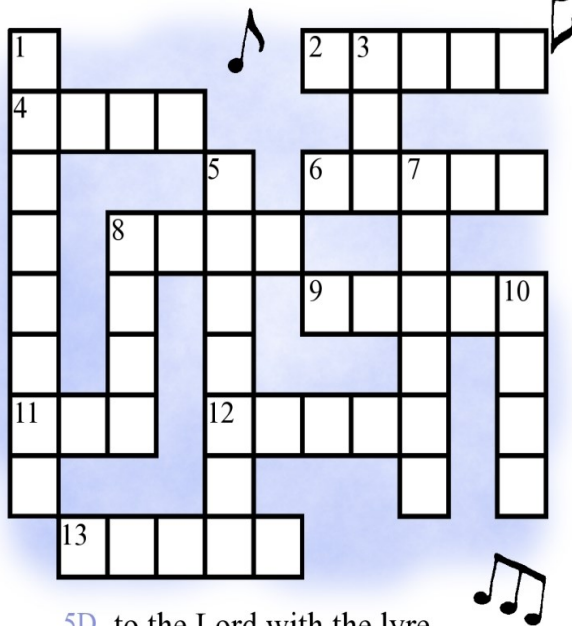
Luke 21:5-19

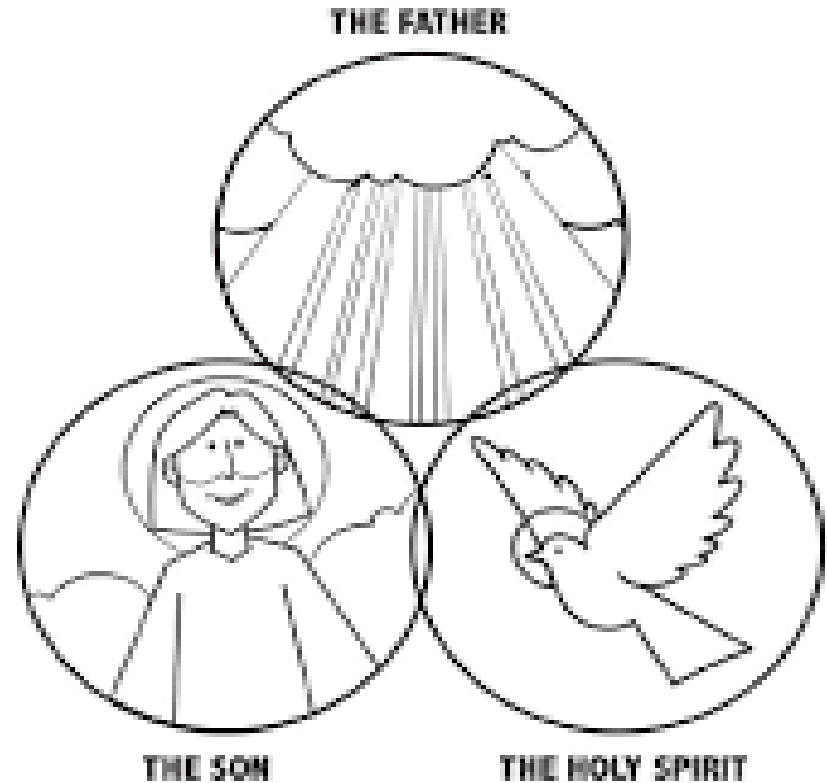
Sing 5D to the Lord with the lyre,
