#### PRAYER BEFORE THE CRIB AT HOME

The history of crib dates back over 800 years, St Francis of Assisi was the first to introduce the crib as a devotional. If you don't have a crib, perhaps you could buy one. If you are creative you could try making one.

On Christmas morning, those who are in the house, gather before the Crib to welcome the Baby Jesus into to your home.

Begin by making the sign of the cross

Light a candle, preferably a Red one as red is the colour of Christmas. It is an Irish tradition of lighting a candle as a sign of welcome.

We welcome the Baby Jesus into our home.

Pray the Hail Mary and other intentions

Finish by making the sign of the Cross.
