Saint of the Week—St. Mel,

7th February St. Mel, Patron Saint of Ardagh & Clonmacnois.

St. Mel died in 488. Mel was a Briton, a disciple of St Patrick, with whom he worked until he was ordained in Ardagh. He is one of the earliest Irish saints and 'gave the religious veil' to St. Brigid.
